Village of Bull Valley, Rules for Off Leash Dog Park:

Hours:

Open 7:00 am to sunset. Park is closed until 12 noon every Wednesday for general maintenance. Park may be temporarily closed without notice for any reason by order of the Village Administrator or Police Department.

USE AT YOUR OWN RISK. The Village of Bull Valley is not responsible for injury, illness or damage to dogs, owners or others using the park. You are responsible for any injury, illness or damage to other dogs or the public caused by your dog.

Your permit sticker will be applied by Village administration to your car's windshield.

Park in lots only. Loitering in lots is prohibited.

Vehicles left after closing will be towed at owner's expense.

No entry to the fenced area without a permit and a dog.

Keep gate closed at all times. Close gate behind you when entering or leaving the fenced area.

Keep your dog leashed while in parking lots, walkways, unfenced areas and while entering and exiting the gate.

All dogs must wear a collar that displays a valid license and rabies vaccination tag.

Owners must carry a leash and accompany dog inside fenced dog area.

No choke, pinch (prong) or spike collars allowed on dogs inside park.

Control your dog and maintain visual contact and voice control at all times.

Dogs are not allowed in any other section of the park.

For your safety and enjoyment inside the park, please:

No more than two dogs per permit are allowed inside the park during any one visit.

No children under 10. Children 11-15 must be accompanied by an adult and are expected to behave appropriately.

Bring appropriate materials and equipment and clean up after your dog. -BYOB (Bring your own bags)

Deposit dog bags and all other litter in proper receptacles.

Dogs must be at least four months old before visiting.

No aggressive dogs allowed. Dogs must be removed immediately on the first sign of aggression.

No dogs in heat allowed. No unneutered males allowed.

Leave nature as you found it for others to enjoy.

Immediately fill any hole your dog digs. A dog that continually digs holes may have permit revoked.

Use this area for dog exercise, obedience and tracking only.

Alcoholic beverages, glass containers, smoking, food, dog food, chews, treats and rawhide are not permitted.

Horses, cats, game animals, birds, bikes, tricycles, strollers, children's toys, off-road motorized vehicles, firearms, fires, fishing, hunting or collecting are prohibited.

For your dog's health and safety please:

Ask your vet's advice about visiting this dog park.

Determine if it is wise for your small dog or puppy to be with larger dogs off leash.

Learn about potential health issues, prevention, symptoms and treatment.

Make sure your dog is healthy and properly vaccinated.

KEEP SICK DOGS AT HOME.

Violations of the above rules may result in a fine and/or suspension or revocation of permit use.
